Definition

- High growth.....
- Turnover growth 20 % a year for 4 years
- Some gazelles are acquisitive/or get eaten up



Why Gazelles are good for Estonia and Latvia

- Create new high value added jobs
- Promote restructuring of regional economy in balance with life-style firms
- Offer potential high returns for investors
- Can play significant role in local society in rural regions
- Keep skilled workers in region – stop brain drain
- Objects of national pride
- Nuclei for new clusters, spur competition and economic change

The process through which something new/original is created

Innovation

The process of introducing Change with commercial return

If Gazelles are fast growing companies

And if these companies are growing fast because they can sell their products and services very well

And if they can sell well because their products and services are sufficiently different and better from the competition

And if that means that these companies can therefore introduce significant change in their markets

Then:

Gazelles are incorporated entities that deliver significant innovation

Conclusion: Framework to support innovation and gazelles is largely the same

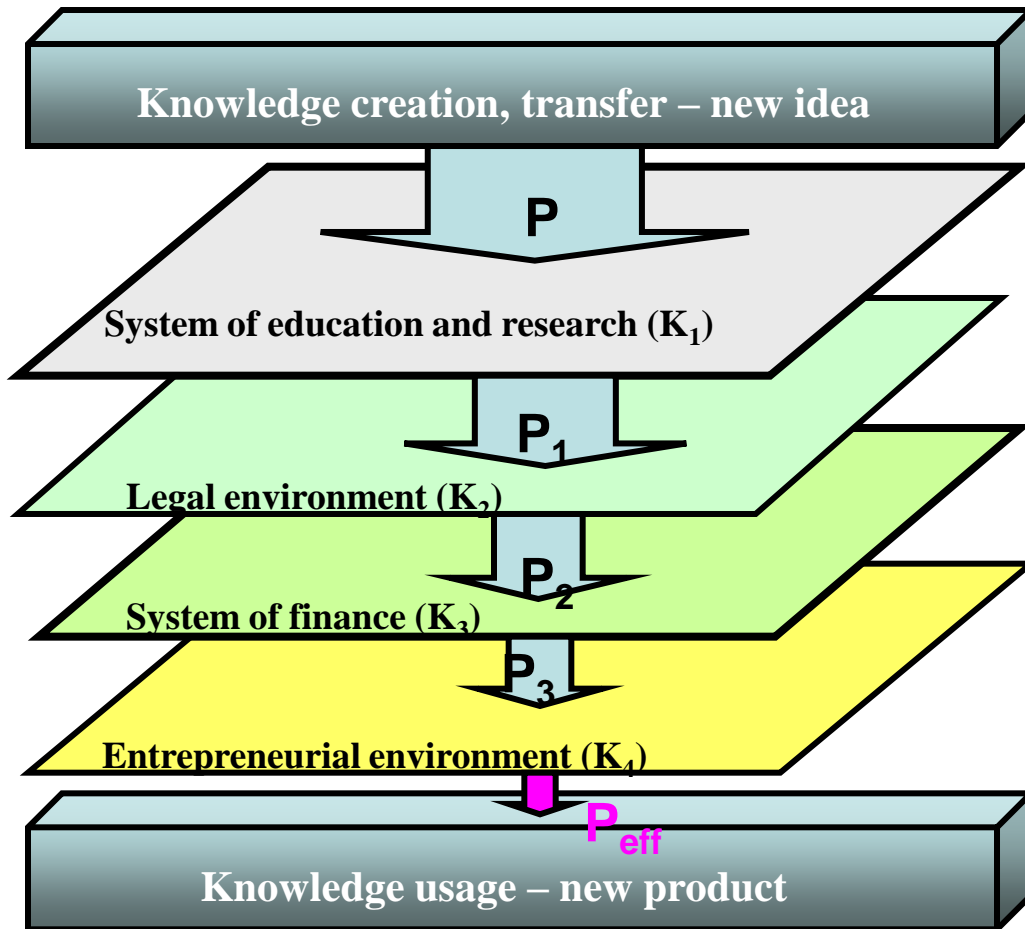

$$P_{\text{eff}} = \text{linov} \times P \times K_1 \times K_2 \times K_3 \times K_4$$

where linov – innovation index in range of 0 to 1;

P_{eff} - share of effectively used knowledge flow;

$K_1 \dots K_4$ – effectiveness of implemented complex innovation policy measures within NIS / RIS (values from 0 to 1).

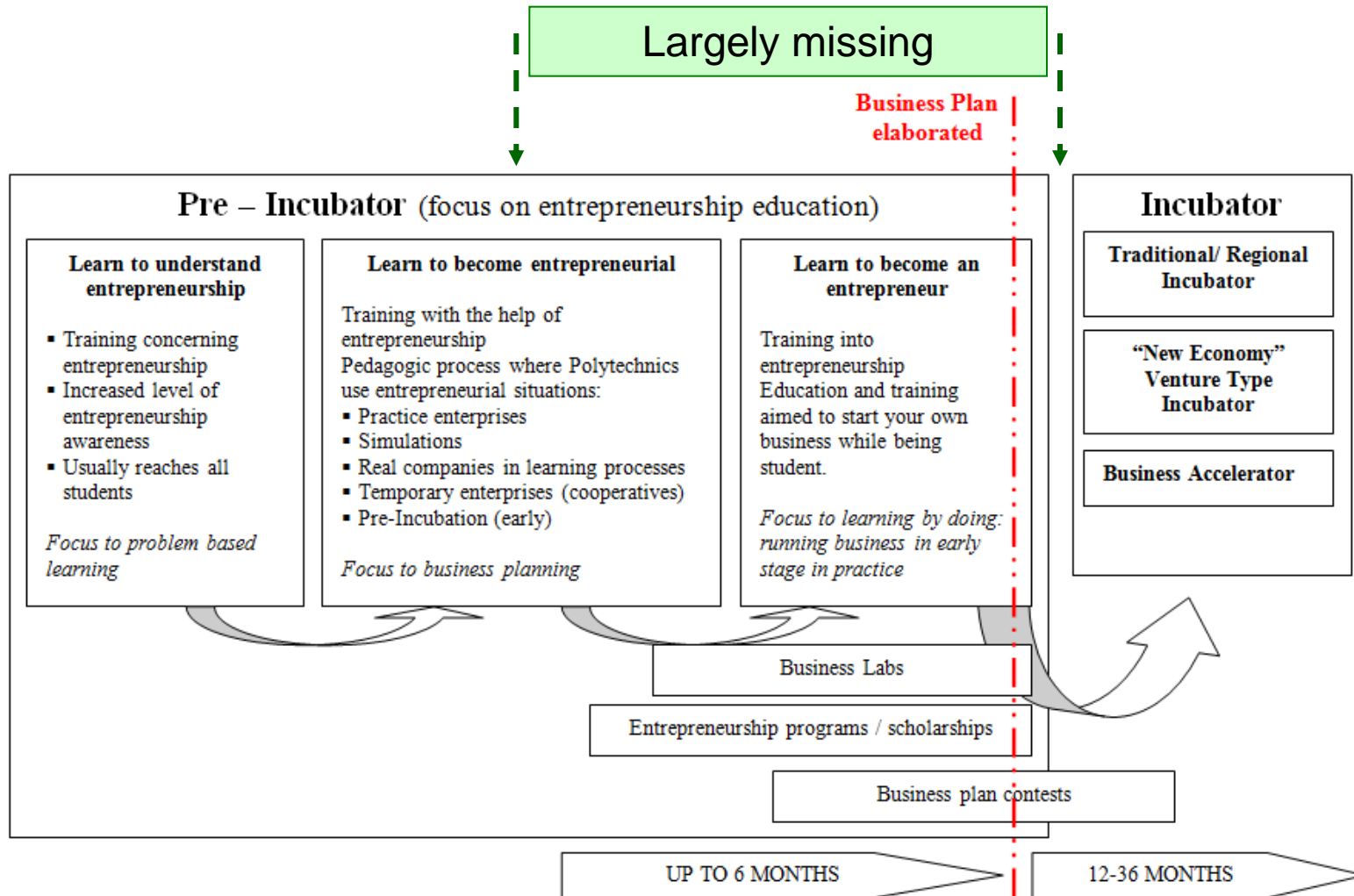

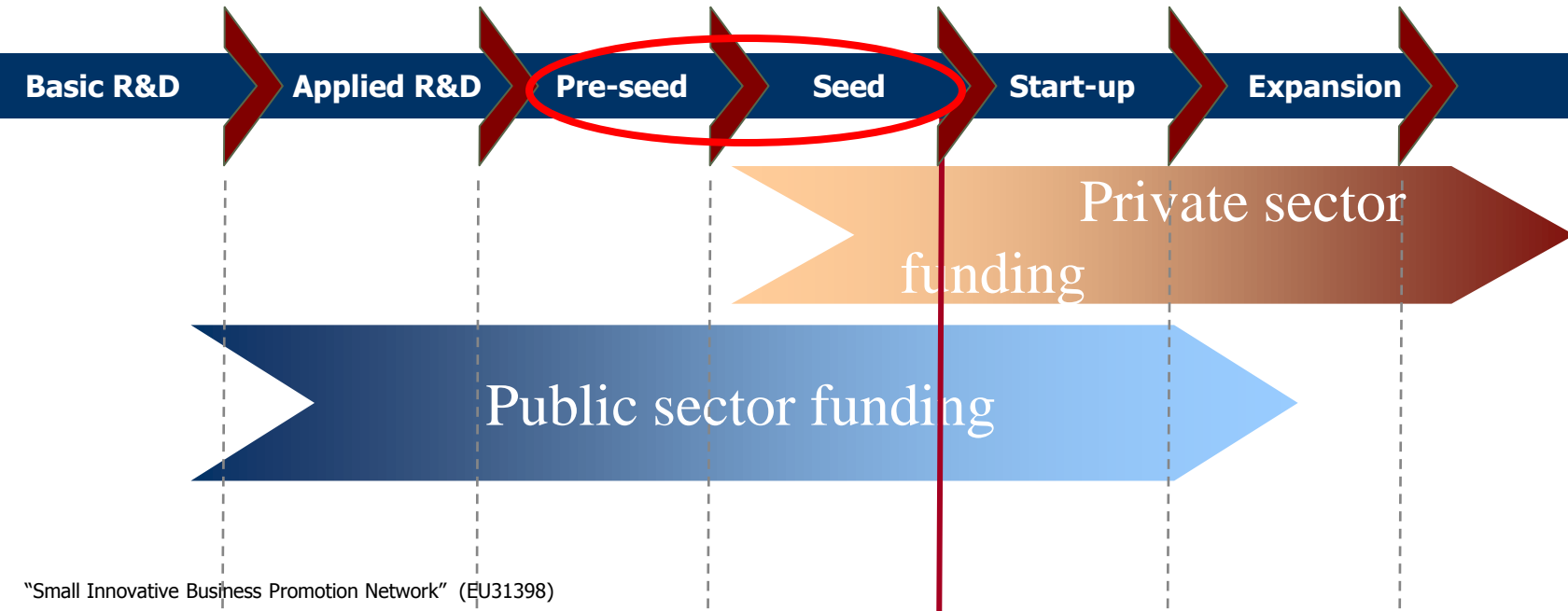

- State need to interfere

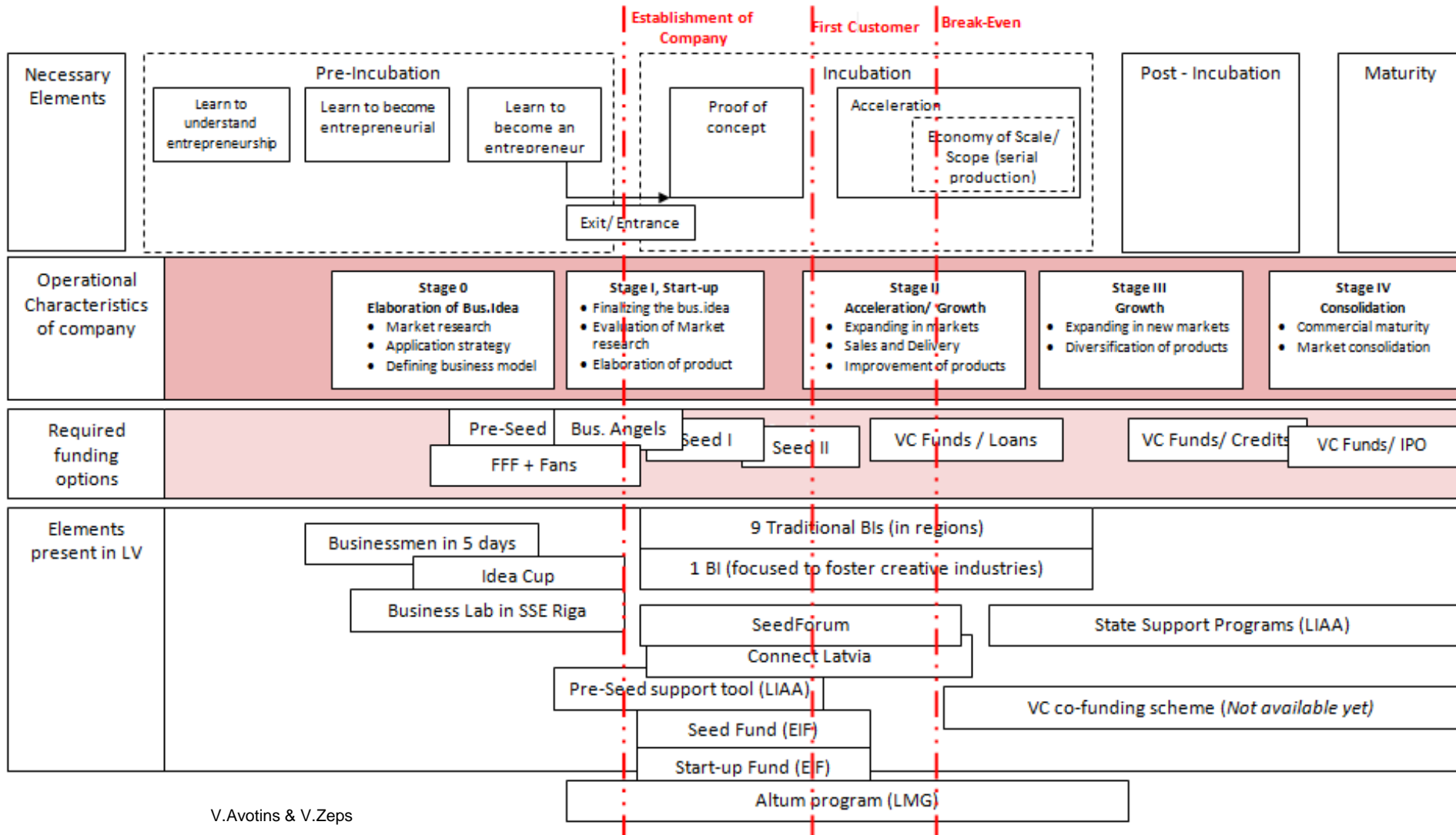

- To promote new innovative high growth firms (e.g. “gazelles”) by
 - encouraging entrepreneurial creativity,
 - evaluating needs for early stage risk finance,
 - providing needed support.
- to release innovative high growth spinouts from regional research centres and Higher Education Institutions fuelled by partnership, mutual learning and mobility activities, as well as required external competence (Kurzeme, Riga and South Estonia) market weaknesses and failures



Project's activities

SIB Net project ensure **complex activity package** to increase creativity, business readiness and develop financial schemes for the support of perspective business ideas:

1. need analysis of innovative new start-ups at the existing situation and needs in the region;
2. establishment of two pre-incubators, creativity forums, investor forums, matching events;
3. development and assessment of the different financial tool concepts to be applicable and most appropriate for the program territory;
4. training of project partners representatives responsible for SME's support activities and exchange of experience.



Planned outputs

1. Need analysis: gazelle needs & risk finance needs,
2. two pre-incubators in Ventspils and Tartu established,
3. two investor forums and two masterclasses,
4. several matching and creativity events,
5. Cross-border idea competition with fine-tuned support services,
6. EU best practices learned – 2 study visits,
7. 4 prefeasibility studies : Proof of Concept and Pre-seed funds, Pre-incubation, Technology incubation, BANs ,
8. Platform for joint pre-incubation and risk capitalists' cross border network
9. Two methodological guides designed – new ideas, pre-incubation
10. Knowledge transfer platform as knowledge and competence transfer mechanism – mobility activities,
11. Awareness creation and level of understanding of the early stage high risk entrepreneurship – workshops and network events.

- Awareness for investment readiness and creativity forums raised amongst the key stakeholders;
- Pre-incubation system created and linked with HEI;
- Raised region's export potential and competitiveness by promotion of 'Gazelle' breakthrough firms;
- Monitoring system created – as a part of innovation system.
- Early stage financing system for 'Gazelles' initiated;
- Created platform and mechanism to set up BAN;
- HEI strategies interlinked with early entrepreneurial and pre-seed competences;
- Policy recommendations designed;

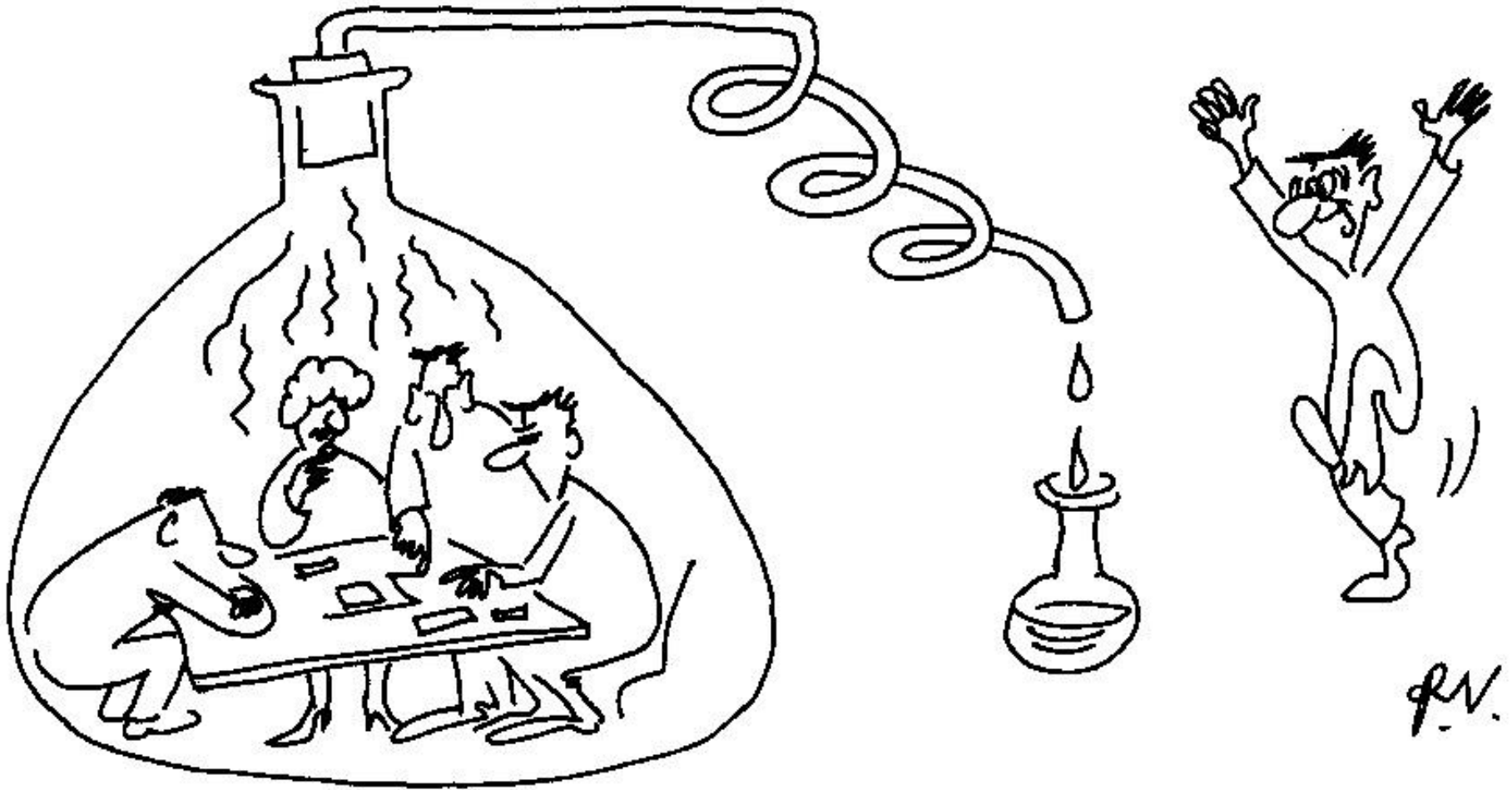
