

Heritage & Community

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personalized perception of a place → unique destination → generate pride, become cherished, viewed & protected as heritage(Szymańska, Grzelak-Kostulska and Hołowiecka, 2009)

both personal and **community** involvement can be defined in the identification, evaluation and safeguarding steps connected to cultural heritage (Rapport and Overing, 2000)

Institutionalized cooperation and management can ensure sustainability (legally, economically, communication-wise etc.) (Fejérdy, 2019)





Actors, involved participants

- Locals (living, working at the location)
- Targeted audience (tourists?)
- Experience creaters (interpreter)
- Subject of heritage (craftsman)
- Political leadership (ensure legal protection)
- Business representatives (economic sustainable, capitalization heritage)
- Heritage experts (nature park)
- Tourism, regional development professionals



• Etc.

- varied expectancies, requirements (such as inhabitants as locals but not owners)
- → new self- or community understanding construction (Bhabha 1994)

 \rightarrow a thorough shared understanding of the property by all stakeholders [...] the involvement of partners and stakeholders (UNESCO, 2005)

Communication, knowledge-sharing and networking

Together you are stronger

 Types of categorization or grouping of actors can be diversed (e.g. relation to heritage, as a communication model)

→ actors themselves should consciously choose their roles regarding the given heritage, meaning personal involvement not just on visitor side but all participants (Lustig, 2009)

 \rightarrow satisfaction in leasure time and business efficiency

Constant commitment and sustainability

Cooperation and not unification



Topics, tasks

- Nature as experience, asset and value
- Connect (transport, participants' network, (digital) communication)
- Preventing mass tourism (diversity of services)
- Sustainability (human resources, capacity, continuous commitment)
- Knowledge sharing (authenticity)

- Check protection (legal, safety etc.) requirements
- Check local experts/involvement
- Connect natural and human/cultural value
- What can be shared how to capitalize
- How to combine all actors
