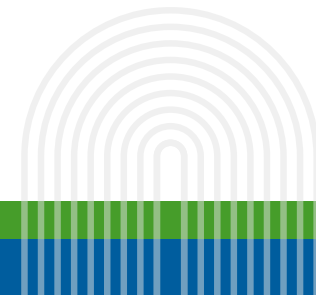

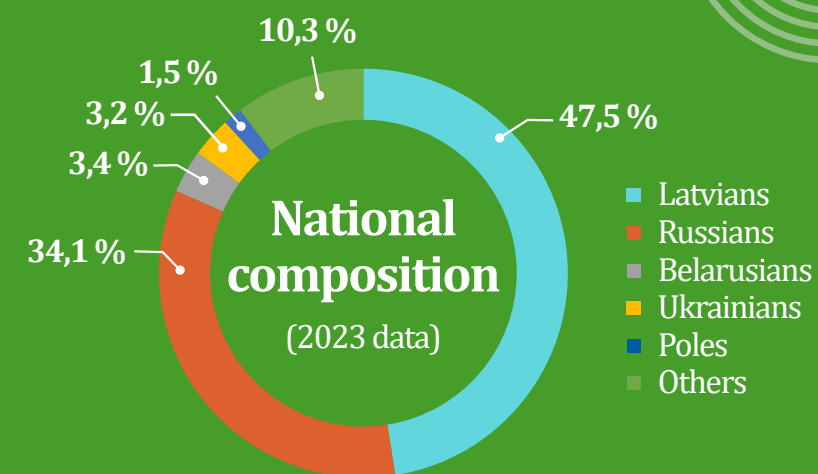
# Jūrmala State City: 100 km<sup>2</sup>

The largest resort city in the Baltics with a 24 km stretch of beach. Development centre of national importance with the potential to contribute to the international recognition and competitiveness of Latvia. The area of forest land in Jūrmala is 48% of the total area of Jūrmala – 5220 ha. There are three specially protected nature areas of European importance in Jūrmala City: Ķemeri National Park, nature reserve Lielupes grīvas pļavas and nature park Ragakāpa.

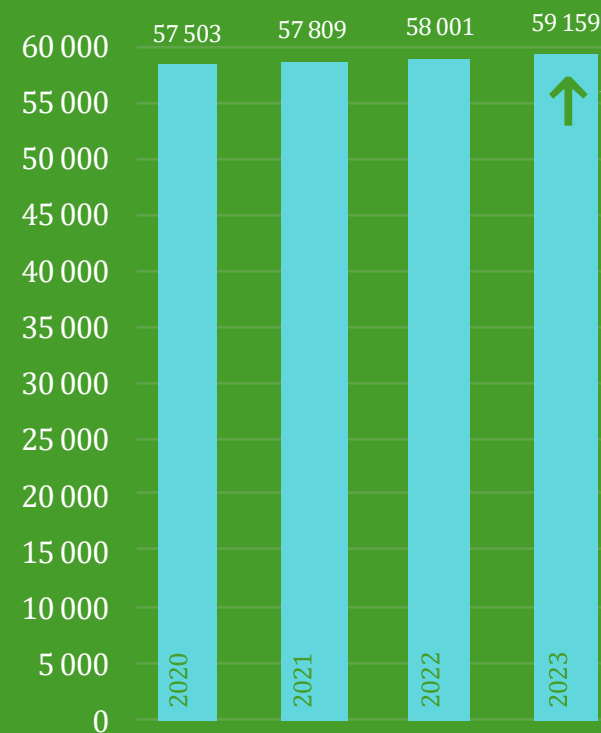


Jūrmala is one of the ten state cities of Latvia. Historically, the city united 12 villages: Priedaine, Lielupe, Bulduri, Dzintari, Majori, Dubulti, Jaundubulti, Pumpuri, Melluži, Asari, Vaivari, Jaunķemeri and two small towns – Sloka and Ķemeri. Now Jūrmala is made up of 26 neighbourhoods.

# Movement within Jūrmala

Riga-Tukums II

Jūrmala and the capital city Riga are connected by the Riga-Tukums II electrified railway line. 45% of Jūrmala's urban areas are within a 10-minute walk from railway stations.

Residents declared in Jūrmala with a valid Jūrmala resident card can use free train trips on the Ķemeri-Rīga-Ķemeri route. Two free tickets per day are available to residents of Jūrmala who have a Jūrmala resident card or a Jūrmala student card and a declared place of residence in Jūrmala Municipality as of 1 January of the current year.



Jūrmala is connected by the A10 highway or the Riga-Ventspils highway. There is a significant daily movement of Jūrmala residents to Riga (work, study, etc.) and in summer – a significant movement of vacationers from Riga to Jūrmala.



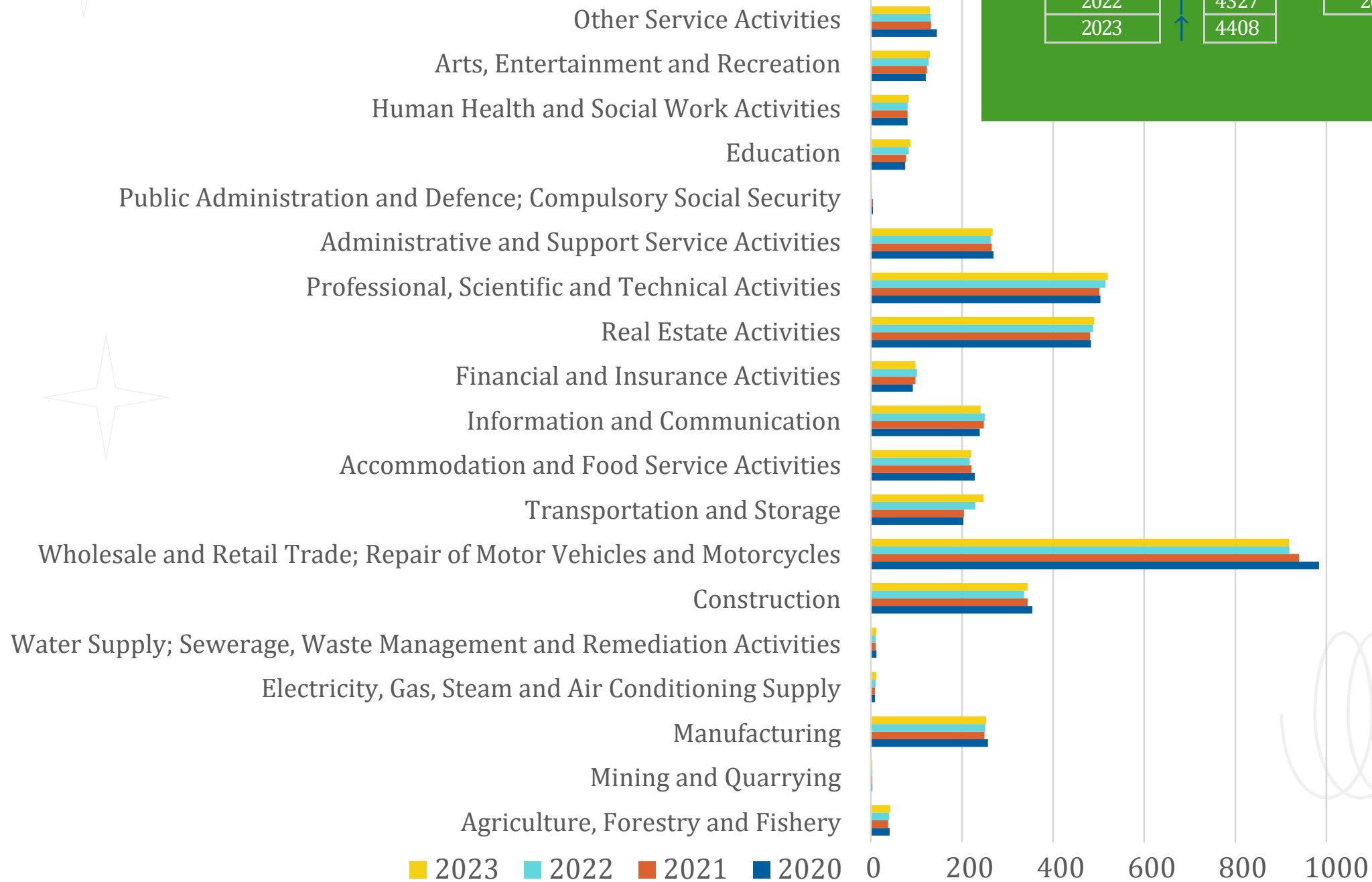
In Jūrmala City, seven yacht clubs and marinas provide docking facilities on the banks of the River Lielupe. In total, there are approximately 100 boat, yacht and motor boat docking places in the city.



Jūrmala residents can easily use both city and intercity bus services, while pupils are provided with school bus routes. Residents declared in Jūrmala can travel free of charge on Jūrmala's public transport routes by presenting their Jūrmala resident card.

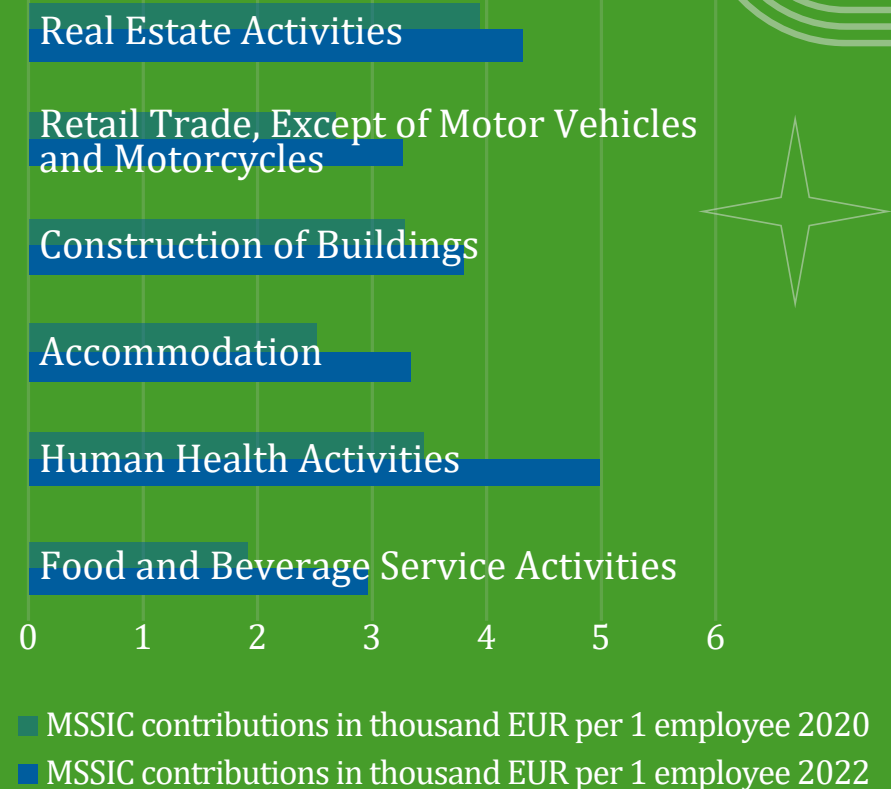

- The Social Integration State Agency.

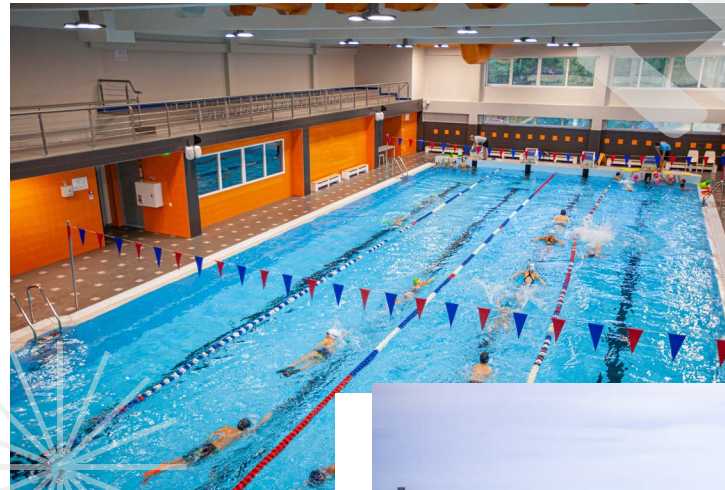


# Sports in Jūrmala

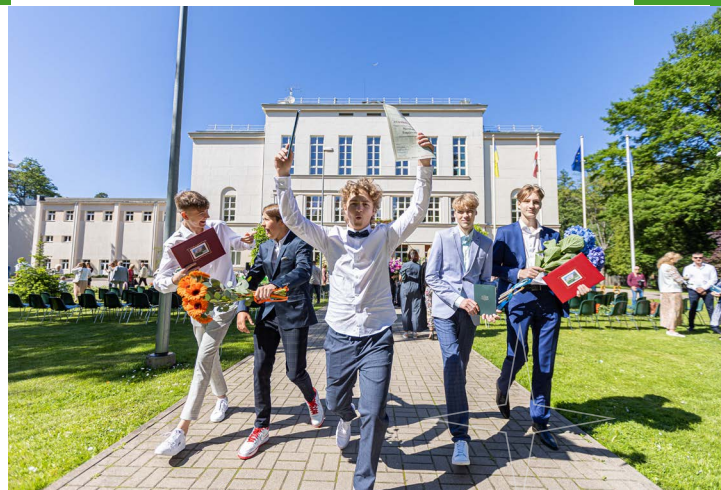

Jūrmala offers various city routes, nature trails, guided tours, digital tours, cycle routes and specially designed tours for pupils.

One of the greatest prides of Jūrmala is its unique wooden architecture. Being aware of the aesthetic appeal of wood and the suitability of the material for seasonal housing, appreciating its positive properties and impact on both human health and environmental pollution, in the 19th century and the first half of the 20th century, buildings in Riga, Jūrmala were mainly constructed from wood, which is why the predominance of wooden buildings over other types of buildings in the city's architecture is noticeable.

The list of architectural monuments includes 408 buildings, 7 of which are sacred buildings – 3 Lutheran, 2 Catholic and 2 Orthodox churches. More than 4000 buildings correspond to the historic buildings of the city.
